

PO1: Multi-disciplinary course covering all major social sciences discipline. Enables to attempt competitive examinations with ease.


PO2: Critical understanding of the domestic and foreign policy enters for making a course in journalism in various positions.


PSO2: Explain the constitutional frame work of various states and analyse the current socio, political, economic and military situation of the state under varying competitive conditions.
